# **COMMUNITY REMINDERS**

## **WINTER WEATHER PREPAREDNESS**

Protect your home during freezing temperatures by covering outdoor faucets, letting indoor faucets drip, and keeping cabinets open to warm pipes. Set your thermostat to at least 65°F and stay tuned for updates on weather conditions and service delays. Stay safe and warm this winter!

## **RV PARKING**

RVs, trailers, campers, boats, and similar vehicles are permitted for a 24-hour period for loading/unloading. During this time, these recreational vehicles may be parked in your driveway or directly in front/rear of your home. Once this 24-hour period has expired all mentioned vehicles must be relocated to the bases designated storage area. If vehicles remain at the home beyond the allotted time, violations will be issued.

## STORAGE & OUTDOOR ITEMS

To maintain a clean and welcoming community, please follow these guidelines:

- Keep patios and balconies free of trash, debris, boxes, and equipment.
- Only use outdoor-specific furniture; indoor items like couches and chairs are not allowed.
- Store bikes, toys, and lawn equipment in the backyard or garage when not in use.
- Ensure patios, balconies, and front yards are neat and tidy at all times.
- Driveways and sidewalks should remain free of oil stains and writing.

## HOUSEKEEPING STANDARDS

All residents are responsible for maintaining their premises in a clean, safe, and sanitary condition. Any unsafe or unsanitary conditions may result in a 48-hour inspection and require corrective action depending on the severity of the issue.

## **MAINTENANCE TIPS**

- HVAC Filters: Keep your heating efficient this winter by ensuring your HVAC filters are clean.
  Contact the office for replacements if needed.
- Drains: Prevent clogs by avoiding pouring grease or oil down the drains, especially during holiday cooking.
- Smoke Detectors: Test your smoke detectors to ensure they're working properly for your safety.
